**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IMPERIAL
APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR BICYCLE AND/OR PEDESTRIAN
FUNDS UNDER SB 821 AND APPROVING THE ADOPTION OF ITS BICYCLE
AND/OR PEDESTRIAN PLAN**

WHEREAS, SB 821 provides that 2% of each county's total Local Transportation Fund be annually set aside and used to fund the development of bicycle and pedestrian facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Imperial has submitted a pedestrian project in conformance with specifications of the City of Imperial Zoning Code and Ordinance and the Regional Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Imperial desires to construct this project within their city utilizing the funds available under SB 821.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Imperial does resolve as follows:

1. To authorize the City Manager as the City's authorized signature and designated contact person;
2. To apply for funds available to the City of Imperial allocated for Bikeways and Pedestrian facilities (SB 821) in the amount of \$18,534.
