BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:						
Rogers & Rogers Automotive Group is proposing to open a new dealership along Preble Road and will likely purchase a strip of land from The Movies. This will result in the removal of parking spaces for the theater which would result in non-compliance with the City's requirements. Currently the zoning code requires one parking space for every five theater seats. Mr. Rogers is requesting that the City revise its requirements to reduce the amount of parking spaces required. There is sufficient parking at The Movies. Only half of all parking spaces were occupied during the busiest day (opening day for Star Wars VII). Rather than establishing a new fixed ratio, it is more practical to require a parking study to determine recommendations for the amount of spaces required; as there are multiple variables that affect the need for parking spaces. The proposed amendment would not affect The Movies but if the facility is expanded or a new theater is added, then a parking demand study will be prepared by the developer and recommendations from the study would have to be met.

## **ORDINANCE NO. 789**
