<i>Confirmation of increase in trash rates by the CPI adjustment of 2% per contract with Allied Waste.</i>	
BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:	
<i>Rate adjustment shall be based upon the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers in the Los Angeles, Orange County and Riverside areas as published by the US Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics for the previous twelve-month period ending in December of each year, for which statistics are available and shall not exceed five (5) percent.</i>	
<i>Current residential trash rate is \$18.34. New residential trash rate will be \$18.71. The new rate will be calculated as of July 1, 2016.</i>

Allied Waste Services is honored to provide integrated solid waste and recycling collection services for the City of Imperial. It is a pleasure to be the City's partner in Waste and Recycling management for the residents and businesses in the City of Imperial.

Under the terms of our contract to provide integrated waste management services to Imperial, Allied is permitted a rate adjustment annually based on the Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers as published by the US Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics for the previous twelve-month period ending in December 31, 2015 for which statistics are available. I have attached a copy of the Consumer Price Index for your review. In December 2015, the CPI index was 2 percent according to CPI index published by the aforementioned.

As per the contract dated August 6th, 2008 between the City of Imperial and Allied Waste Transportation, the following rate changes will apply effective July 1st 2016:

- Commercial and Roll-off construction and demolition rates will be subject to the annual CPI adjustment of 2 percent.
- Residential rates will be subject to the annual CPI adjustment of 2 percent. The current monthly rate is \$18.34 per resident. The new rate is \$18.71. This is the amount due to Allied Waste.

Thank you for the privilege of allowing us to provide solid waste collection and recycling service to the residents of Imperial. Allied is proud to serve and continue its partnership with the community and City of Imperial.
