SUBJECT: DISCUSSION/ACTION: SB1 The Road Repair & Accountability Act – Storm Drain Design Services	
DEPARTMENT INVOLVED: COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT	
BACKGROUND/SUMMARY: The City was able to secure funds through SB1 The Road Repair & Accountability Act. SB1 increases per gallon fuel excise taxes; increases diesel fuel sales taxes and vehicle registration fees; and provides for inflationary adjustments to tax rates in future years. Storm drain design and installation on 11th Street from F Street to Old SR86. Construction is anticipated to start January 2018. Staff released request for proposals to known Engineering Companies in the Imperial Valley and Southern California Regions. Bid proposals were opened September 4, 2018. The following five companies submitted proposals for storm drain designed services: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Alfred Civil Engineering \$7,480</li> <li>2. Webb &amp; Associates \$24,650</li> <li>3. Dudek \$79,656</li> <li>4. BJ Engineering \$14,760</li> <li>5. Dynamic Consulting Engineers \$38,700</li> </ol> After carefully reviewing each proposal submitted, staff is recommending Storm drain design services be awarded to Alfred Civil Engineering as it is by far the lowest proposal and most advantageous to the city.
