BACKGROUND/SUMMARY

On November 7, 2016 at approximately 6:00 pm, staff was alerted to a force main sewer line break in the vicinity of Clark Blvd and Aten Blvd just east of the Clark lift station. City crew along with Primo Construction, Ancon, Top Dollar Recycling Inc. worked throughout the night making repairs and transporting wastewater from the Clark Pump Station to the treatment facility. The line is now repaired and additional parts are on order for the line. Clean-up of the spillage was conducted in compliance with state regulations. Emergency action was taken to protect the public health and safety and to protect property.

FISCAL IMPACT: Unknown at this time.

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF IMPERIAL DECLARING AN EMERGENCY,
RATIFYING ACTION TAKEN BY THE CITY MANAGER AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE SUCH FURTHER
ACTION AS MAY BE NECESSARY IN RESPONSE THERETO**

WHEREAS, The City of Imperial operates a wastewater collection and treatment facility (“System”); and

WHEREAS, the System includes a pump station located in the vicinity of Aten Blvd and Clark Blvd (“Pump Station”) which serves the Sandalwood Glen, Reflections and Wildflower Subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, a 10’ force main line leaves the pump station to connect to the wastewater treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, a break in the 10’ force main line occurred causing spillage of untreated wastewater; and

WHEREAS in order to safeguard the public health and safety and to protect property it is necessary to take immediate action to repair the force main and clean-up the spillage; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to ratify any action taken to date by the City Manager to address the condition described herein and further wishes to approve the repair and clean-up performed by Primo Construction, Ancon Company; and Top Dollar Recycling Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The above-referenced recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.
2. The City Council declares that the public interest and necessity demand the immediate expenditure of public money to safeguard life, health or property and hereby ratifies any action by the City Manager to repair the force main and clean-up of spillage.
3. The City Council in order to safeguard life, health or property, hereby approves the repairs and clean-up performed by Primo Construction, Ancon Company, and Top Dollar.
4. The City Council authorizes action set forth herein on the basis that the emergency described herein will not permit delay resulting from a competitive solicitation of bids and the action is necessary to respond to the emergency.
