**Subject:** Proposed No Parking Signs/ Red Curb on Shiloh Way

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## Background

Historically, Shiloh Way was an access way used by the Imperial County. Since the City acquired Shiloh Way, it has become a heavily used access due to the businesses and residential uses that surround it—mainly 4:13 gym, the apartment complex and Tucker auto body and towing.

- Safety concerns regarding pedestrians in the area have been expressed to City staff by citizens.
- Safety concerns regarding parking and street access have been expressed to City staff by citizens.
- The parking congestion that is occurring on Shiloh Way also poses a potential interference with safety and response time issues regarding first responders, if they are summoned to that area.

An official traffic study of the location has not yet been conducted, but the vehicular volume witnessed is significant.

Staff recommends the placement of "No Parking" signs and red curbing on Shiloh Way. Please look at the attachment that depicts the placement locations boundary. Staff believes this will be a positive step towards addressing the safety and congestion concerns for Shiloh Way.

## Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends this item to the Traffic Commission for discussion and action.

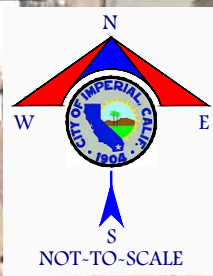
