Subject: Similar Land Use Determination- Gym Business within I-1: General Industrial Zone

Background

Alejandro Rodriguez filed a planning permit application for a Similar Land Use Determination of a proposed gym business to be located at 612 S. J Street in the City of Imperial. The suite is 1650 square feet. The proposed gym business is attempting to relocate to this location from a C-1 zone that is located 4 blocks north of the proposed location at 207 E. Barioni Avenue.

The I-1: General Industrial Zone does allow "businesses, professional services, and research offices" under section 24.07.120 letter "C" of the zoning ordinance; however the industrial zoning ordinance does not reference gyms.

Discussion/Analysis

The Zoning Code is written such that, only those uses listed are allowed to be located within the specific zones, but a Classification of Use Determination would allow the Planning Commission to determine whether or not a proposed use is similar to, or not more detrimental than a use that is already permitted.

The City of Imperials' zoning ordinance "definitions" section, does not contain a definition nor categorize such uses that would fall under "business, professional or research". The proposed gym is being compared to Section 24.07.120 letter "C" of the Industrial Zoning Ordinance of the City of Imperial.

Evaluation

Upon review of the proposed use, staff has found the proposed gym business location to be compatible with the uses surrounding the proposed location which, is within a business center comprised of a restaurant and other professional businesses.

Historically and currently, there is a "CrossFit" of Imperial Valley operating in an I-1 zone.

Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends this item to the Planning Commission for review and action.
