ADDENDUM No. 2

TO THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND SPECIFICATIONS.

Bidders are advised that the contract documents and specifications for the above referenced contract are hereby amended in the following manner and the following manner only:

This Addendum answers bidder's questions.

1. Question: *On page 36, the specs say this is a 60 day project. On page 43 the specs say it is a 30 day project. Can the City clarify?*

Response: *The paragraph under 6-7 Time of Completion, 6-7.1 General on page 43 shall read as follows:*

"The time for completion shall be 60 working days from the issuance date of the Notice to Proceed"

2. Question: *On page 44 the specs say LDs of \$ 827. On page 140 the specs say LD's are \$ 200. Can the City clarify?*

Response: *The last sentence under paragraph 6-9 Liquidated Damages on page 44 shall read as follows:*

"..... the Contractor shall pay to the Agency, or have withheld from monies due it, the sum of \$200 per calendar day"

3. Question: *The specs reference Repairs to the Road Bed, Slurry Seal, & Crack Seal with no pay items. Can you confirm these and several other items referenced in the specs with no pay items are not part of the scope?*

Response: *The only bid items for the project are the ones listed in the Proposal Bid Sheet, if any items reference in the specifications are not listed in the Proposal Bid Sheet thence they are not part of the scope of work.*

4. Question: *The bid proposal sheet makes reference to Burrowing Owl Survey, Training, and other measures. Will the costs for these items be paid by the City?*

Response: *Yes, the cost for the burrowing owl survey, training and other measures will be paid by the City.*

5. Question: *The bid proposal sheet makes reference to Lead Paint and Aerially deposited Lead in exposed soil. Will the costs for a Lead Plan and Remediation be paid by the City?*

Response: *Since the cold mill (AC grinding) will be done through-out large pavement areas, there will be no need of a Lead Plan and Remediation to be done and/or paid separately. In the event that a lead plan and remediation are required, they will be paid by the City.*


6. Question: *The DBE goal for this project is 14%, but the parts of the project that can be subcontracted are limited. 14% is a higher than normal goal for this type of project in the region. Is it possible for the goal to be adjusted to reflect the nature of this project?*

Response: *The first sentence under the 8th paragraph of the Notice of Inviting Sealed Bids on page 1 shall read as follows:*

"This project has a specific contract Disadvantage Businesses Enterprises (DBE) Contract Goal of 9%,....."
