The services will automatically be transferred to the Landlord effective as of the date of disconnect by the tenant. The services will remain in the name of the Landlord until an application for services is signed by a new tenant or until the Landlord submits written request that the service be disconnected, thereby canceling this agreement.				
	b.	the services are connected in his/her name in accordance with the established rate schedules of the City. If a charge incurred by the Landlord is not paid within 30 days after disconnect, this agreement may be canceled and existing services under this agreement may be disconnected for nonpayment of the delinquent account.
