BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

In the 2017 Wastewater Rate Study, capital improvements / aging infrastructure projects were identified. The City's sewer system requires a significant amount of repair and improvement projects. The largest of the projects is a new sewer treatment plant. The new plant will replace the current one which has served long past its useful life.

Additionally, the 2005 Parity Certificates of Participation will be refunded at a lower interest rate (estimated reduction of 1.20%) by saving approximately \$545,789 over 17 years. The 2005 COP issuance was \$2,845,000 and the current Refunding balance is \$2,025,000.

The combined rate increases from FY 17-18 to FY 21-22 allow for the City to issue debt and to maintain a debt coverage ratio above 1.25x. This helps the City to maintain a strong financial position and be better positioned when obtaining additional financing.
