DISCUSSION/ACTION: APPROVE / DISAPPROVE STRIPPING OF OUTSTANDING COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT TAXES TO 2004-02 (MAYFIELD) AND 2004-3 (BRATTON).

APPROVAL TO PROCEED WITH STRIPPING OF DELINQUENT SPECIAL TAX INSTALLMENTS FOR THE COUNTY TAX ROLL FOR COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 2004-2 (MAYFIELD) AND No. 2004-3 (BRATRON) FOR 2016-2017, 2017-2018, AND 2018-2019.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

Recently the County of Imperial during their delinquent tax sale of tax-deeded properties sold 98 parcels at a reduced minimum bid amount, as permitted in §3698.5 of the Revenue and Taxation Code. 97 parcels are located in 2004-02 (Mayfield) and 1 in 2004-03 (Bratton). The amount received by the County of Imperial was not sufficient to cover the statutory amount due to redeem these parcels, so a calculated pro rata share is being applied to each assessment fund. Outstanding for 2004-02 (Mayfield) is \$322,314.56 and the pro rata share would be approximately \$161,157.28. Outstanding for 2004-03 (Bratton) is \$24,413.73 and the pro rata share would be approximately \$19,530.98.

The County of Imperial has requested notification from the City as to how to proceed with either acceptance of the pro rata share or to strip the CFD's off of each tax roll.
