**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IMPERIAL,  
CALIFORNIA APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR BICYCLE AND/OR  
PEDESTRIAN FUNDS UNDER THE TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT AND  
APPROVING THE ADOPTING OF ITS BICYCLE AND/OR PEDESTRIAN PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, The Transportation Development Act provides that 2 percent of each county's total Local Transportation Fund be annually set aside and used to fund the development of bicycle and pedestrian facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Imperial has planned a bikeway system in conformance with specification of Caltrans' *Planning and Design Criteria for Bikeways in California*, and the Regional Transportation Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Imperial desires to construct this project within their city using the funds available under the Transportation Development Act.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Imperial does resolve as follows:

1. To authorize the City Manager as the City's authorized signature and designated contact person;
2. To apply for funds available to the City of \$21,940. Allocated for Bikeways and Pedestrian facilities.
