Dear Mr. Loper:

We have reviewed the two (2) bid proposals received on March 26, 2020 for the above referenced project. The low bid proposal of \$356,772.00 was received from Cora Constructors, Inc. (Cora) of Palm Desert, California. The second bid of \$538,267.00 was from Abhe & Svoboda, Inc. (A&S) of Alpine, California.

Based upon Webb's review of Cora's and A&S's proposals, both were found to comply with the requirements and intent of the specifications. Our routine check of the contractor licenses for the two bidders, using the California Contractors State License Board's website, indicated that both licenses are in good standing.

A review of the Certified Data Sheet submitted by Cora in their proposal included valves and operators acceptable for the work.

Based upon our review and evaluation of the bid proposals and the engineer's estimate of \$367,000, Webb recommends that the City award the contract for the referenced project to Cora in the amount of \$356,772.00.
