To Whom It May Concern:

The El Centro Border Patrol Station is hosting the 14th annual Imperial Valley Law Enforcement Relay Run. This is a relay race that takes place during Police Week to remember the fallen Officers. The date of the race is Saturday May 13, 2023. The race is scheduled to start at 6:00 AM and will last approximately 4 hours. The starting point is at the El Centro Border Patrol Station on Aten Road. It will then head to Mead Street, via Old Highway 111, and then return to the El Centro Station.

The runners will be running on the east and west side shoulder of Old Highway 111. Each runner will have a safety vehicle behind them with their hazard lights on. The vehicles will also be off to the shoulder as to not impede or obstruct traffic. There will also be 4-5 Emergency Medical Technicians assigned to the race. They will be roving Old Highway 111 and respond to any medical emergencies. It is anticipated that approximately ten to fifteen teams consisting of ten runners will be participating in the race. There will be no roadblocks or road closures during the event.
