SUBJECT: DISCUSSION/ACTION: IMPERIAL COUNTY AIRPORT 1. APPROVAL OF JOINT LETTER/POSITION WITH COUNTY OF IMPERIAL REGARDING LIMITATION OF HOURS OF OPERATION FOR FUEL SERVICES AT IMPERIAL COUNTY AIRPORT

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY: During our Regular Meeting of the City Council, concerns were raised regarding extended hours of operations for fueling services at Imperial County Airport. Numerous complaints have been received by residents regarding the late/night early morning "hot fueling" of military aircraft at Imperial County Airport. A meeting was held between City of Imperial staff, Councilmember Dale, Mayor Pro-Tem Eugenio, County of Imperial staff, and Supervisor Mike Kelley to review the concerns. It was discussed that a joint letter and position of support be considered by each other's respective governing boards to contact Imperial Flying Service and surrounding military bases. The goal is to come to a resolution, limit the hours of operation within reason to the Imperial Community, and continue to provide the essential service to our military.
