GANN SPENDING LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025

1. CERTIFY THE CITY IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE GANN SPENDING LIMIT FOR FY 2024-2025 BY APPROVING RESOLUTION #2024-48.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

As required by Proposition 4 which was passed in 1979, now under Article XIIIB of the California Constitution, the City of Imperial (like all California Cities) has had to determine compliance with Proposition 4 by multiplying the "base" spending limit established for each City back in the year 1979 using the two factors provided by the California Department of Finance: (1) population change, and (2) inflation rate change, annually.

Known broadly as the Gann Spending Limit, named after Paul Gann, a political activist who joined forces with Howard Jarvis to bring about the well-known Proposition 13, which places a limit on property taxes at 1% of assessed value, with no more than a 2% growth rate on assessed values (with certain exceptions).

The purpose of the Gann Spending Limit is to annually, as part of the budget adoption process, update the prior-year Spending Limit by multiplying that limit by the new-year compounding impact of the new population change (2.59%) by the new inflation rate change (3.62%).

For FY 2024-2025, here is the calculation of the Gann Spending Limit (adding 100% to each factor to allow multiplication of the percentages against last year's limit):

$$21,528,421 \times 1.0259 \times 1.0362 = 22,884,712$$

The other test to the Gann Spending Limit is to calculate the appropriations "subject to" the spending limit. This is an odd calculation, but it basically calls for determining the "revenues" derived primarily from "tax" proceeds (generally in the General Fund), and uses this figure to establish the "appropriations" that are subject to the limit.

In Imperial, this figure totals \$8,921,700, which is well below the \$22,884,712 spending limit.

FISCAL IMPACT: None. Resolution #2024-48 establishes the spending limit for FY 2025 at \$22,884,712, which is well under the \$8,921,700 appropriations "subject to" the spending limit.

Purpose of Limited Procedures Review

Under ArticleXIIIB of the California Constitution (the Gann Spending Limit Initative),
California governmental agencies are restricted as to the amount of annual appropriations from
proceed of taxes. Effective for years beginning on or after July 1, 1990, under Section 1.5 of Article XIIIB,
the annual calculation of the appropriations limit is subject to a limited procedures review in connection
with the annual audit.

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Imperial as follows:

WHEREAS, the Gann Initiative, hereby referred to as Article XIIB of the Constitution of the State of California was passed by the people; and

WHEREAS, Article XIIB mandated and appropriations limit on various units of government, including the City of Imperial; and

WHEREAS, that limit has been calculated by the Administrative Services Department of the City of Imperial using current guidelines by State Department of Finance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Imperial desires to formally adopt that appropriations limit for the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Imperial, in accordance with Article XIIB of the Constitution of the State of California hereby adopts an appropriation limit for the City of Imperial for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 at \$22,884,712, which is an increase of \$1,356,291 over Fiscal Year 2023-2024 limit of \$21,528,421, using the California Department of Finance data, which reflects a 2.59% population increase and a 3.62% inflation increase for the new fiscal year.

The appropriations subject to the limit for FY 2023-2024 total \$8,921,700, which are well below the FY 2024-2025 appropriations limit of \$22,884,712 as computed in Attachment 1.
