## BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

The Community Development Department was directed by City Council to conduct a competitive BID process for the above-referenced project.

The scope-of-work included the installation of reinforced concrete elliptical storm drain pipes, drop inlets, and manholes, as well as grinding of the whole cross-section of existing asphalt pavement, installation of conventional asphalt leveling course, asphalt-rubber aggregate membrane (ARAM), gap graded asphalt-rubber hot mix, utility adjustments and traffic control.

Staff released a BID published in the Imperial Valley Press, our City website, as well as planrooms to solicit proposals from contractors to complete the construction.

Two (2) bids were received during the formal bidding process from "Hazard Construction, Inc." and "Granite Construction, Inc". See attached Exhibit 1 ("BID Opening Act") for details.

Granite's proposal failed to provide the amount for one (1) bid item, while Hazard's proposal was found to be substantially exceeding the cost estimate prepared for this project.
