## AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE IMPERIAL VALLEY DRUG COALITION LAW ENFORCEMENT COORDINATION CENTER AND THE CITY OF IMPERIAL

This agreement (Agreement) is made this	day of	2021, between the Imperial Valley
Drug Coalition Law Enforcement Coordination	on Center ('	"IVDC-LECC") and the City of Imperial
("City").		

This Agreement is made in reference to the following:

- A. The City is a signatory to the Imperial Valley Drug Coalition Law Enforcement Coordination Center Memorandum of Understanding (LECC-MOU) with a term of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024;
- B. The LECC-MOU provides the parameters for signatory agencies as to collocation, administration, sharing and flow of information in High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) multi-agency, counter-narcotic operational and intelligence environment.
- C. The LECC-MOU provides that participating agencies may have personnel assigned to the IVDC-LECC who will be tasked with specific duties. These employees may be funded through HIDTA.
- D. The IVDC-LECC and the City desire that the City collocate one full-time criminal analyst position, under terms and conditions consistent with the LECC-MOU, to be funded in the manner set forth in this Agreement.

## IVDC-LECC and City hereby agree as follows:

- City agrees to provide one (1) criminal analyst to the IVDC-LECC Intelligence Group for collocation at the LECC. During this period of assignment, the criminal analyst will be under the direct supervision and control of the IVDC-LECC supervisory personnel assigned to the LECC. The criminal analyst position at the LECC will be based on the availability of HIDTA grant funds.
- 2. During the period of assignment, the City will remain responsible for establishing the salary and benefits of the criminal analyst assigned to the LECC, and for making all payments due them.
- 3. The City shall be reimbursed through HIDTA funding for all costs associated with the criminal analyst's salary through HIDTA funding. Reimbursable costs for the first year of this Agreement shall not exceed Sixty-Five Thousand, Six Hundred, Nineteen Dollars (\$65,619.00). Fringe benefits, such as bilingual pay, wellness, and tuition reimbursement, shall not be reimbursed though HIDTA funding.
- 4. City shall maintain complete and accurate records and accounts of all obligations and expenditures under this agreement in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles (GAAP) to facilitate on-site inspection and auditing of such records and accounts.

5. The term of this agreement shall be effective from the date in the first paragraph until HIDTA grant funds are no longer available or by written notification of either party. This agreement may be terminated by either party on thirty (30) days advance written notice. Billing for all outstanding obligations must be received by HIDTA within ninety (90) days of the date of termination of this Agreement.
