Subject: RESULTS OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION OF NOVEMBER 6, 2018

#### **Background and Summary**

The City of Imperial consolidates the General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election and the County of Imperial Elections Department provides certain election services, including a canvass of the votes cast in the General Municipal Election.

At a regular meeting held June 6, 2018, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2018-14 calling for a General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, for the purpose of election of three members of the City Council for the full term of four years.

At the same meeting, the City Council adopted Resolutions 2018-17 and 2018-20, ordering two measures be placed on the ballot.

The first measure, Measure H, placed before voters the questions. "Shall the office of the city treasurer be appointive?"

The second measure, Measure I, placed before voters the question, "to fund general municipal expenses such as police, fire, roads and recreation, shall the City tax cannabis (marijuana) businesses at annual rates not to exceed \$10.00 per canopy square foot for cultivation (adjustable for inflation), 6% of gross receipts for retail cannabis businesses, and 4% for all other cannabis businesses; which is expected to generate an estimated \$40,000 to \$60,000 thousand annually and will be levied until repealed by the voters or the City Council?"

There were five qualified candidates for the office of Council Member; Geoff Dale, James Tucker, Karin Eugenio, and Betty Sampson. Upon certification by the Registrar of Voters, Karin Eugenio, James Tucker and Geoff Dale have been elected to serve as a member of the City Council. A majority of the voters voted in favor of Measures H and I.

It is requested that pursuant to California Election Code Section 15400, the City Council declares the results of the canvass of votes. The resolution included, reciting the fact of the City of Imperial General Municipal Election held on November 6, 2018 and

declaring the result thereof as stated in the Certificate of the Canvass of Votes is submitted for Council's adoption.

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2018-67**

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IMPERIAL, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 6, 2018 DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Imperial, California, on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received, and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form, and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, the County Election Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IMPERIAL, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1**. That the whole number of votes (ballots) cast in the precincts except vote by mail voter ballots and provisional ballots was 1,638.

That the whole number of votes by mail voter ballots cast and provisional ballots cast in the City was 2,511, making a total of 4,149 votes (ballots) cast in the City.

**SECTION 2.** That the names of persons voted for at the election for Member of the City Council are as follows:

Geoff Dale

James Tucker

Nicole R. Olguin

Karin S. Eugenio

**Betty Sampson** 

That the measures voted upon at the election are as follows:

Measure H, pertaining to the office of the City Treasurer.

Measure I, pertaining to imposition of Cannabis Tax

**SECTION 3**. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons above named for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates and for and against the measures were as listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

SECTION 4. The City Council does declare and determine that:

Karin S. Eugenio was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years;

James Tucker was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years; Geoff Dale was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years.

That as a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on the measures relating to H and I did vote in favor of it, and that the measures were carried and shall be deemed adopted and ratified.

**SECTION 5**. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the result of the election, showing:

- (1) The whole number of votes cast in the City;
- (2) The names of the persons voted for;
- (3) The measures voted upon;
- (4) For what office each person was voted for;
- (5) The number of votes given at each precinct to each person; and for and against each measure; and
- (6) The total number of votes given to each person, and for and against each measure.

**SECTION 6.** That the City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

**SECTION 7**. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
