Designed for kids ages 11-14, the Red Cross Junior Lifeguard Program helps build a foundation of knowledge, attitudes and skills for future lifeguards. This one-week program develops swimming skills and in-water rescue skills, demonstrates how to use rescue equipment safely and effectively, develops leadership and team work, introduces first aid, CPR, and AED knowledge and skills. Before entering Junior Lifeguarding, participants must demonstrate the following skills:

- Swim the front crawl for 25 yards continuously while breathing to the front or side
- Swim the breaststroke for 25 yards using a pull, breathe, kick and glide sequence
- Tread water for 1 minute using arms and legs
- Show a level of comfort on the back by floating on the back for 30 seconds or swimming on the back for 25 yards using the elementary backstroke or back crawl
- Submerge and swim a distance of 10 feet under water.
